Nancy Oliveira has traveled to several states and countries to speak out about the death penalty. She is the author of Writing Wrongs, a booklet which teaches individuals how to harness the power of the press to work for social justice. Christine Thomas has worked in public defender services from trial to capital habeas since 1988. She is currently employed with the Federal Defenders Office in Sacramento as a paralegal on the Capital Habeas Unit. Shortly after beginning work with the public defenders office in Wisconsin, she began to see how society marginalizes and disenfranchises those in poverty, those who are drug addicted, people of color, and those who are mentally ill. Christine is a Sacramento County board member of the ACLU, Democratic Party Platform Committee Member, and an activist for ending the death penalty and prison and sentencing reform.
